


# DOMINO EFFECT OF PRIMARY CARE



A RELATIONSHIP WITH A PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN HAS A DIRECT IMPACT ON BOTH EMPLOYEE HEALTH AND EMPLOYER COST.

# **DOMINO EFFECT**

Having a relationship with a primary care physician (PCP) has a direct impact on both employee and employer cost.

Our data demonstrates that annual engagement with a PCP leads to managed chronic conditions, improved compliance with age/gender screenings, and early disease detection. These combined outcomes result in enhanced health for your employees and their family members, and stabilized healthcare costs for all.

## **5 YEARS OF DATA ANALYSIS ILLUSTRATES:**



### AN ANNUAL PCP VISIT SAVES MONEY

Employees who have an annual PCP visit cost the health plan 11% less (\$686) per member per year than employees without a visit. 1

Spouses without an annual visit cost 21% more than spouses with a visit. 1

Simply put, with a PCP relationship, employees can maintain or improve their health and employers can contain, and in some cases, improve costs.

### PCP VISIT IMPACTS EARLY DETECTION



Patients with an annual PCP visit are 2x more likely to comply with age and gender appropriate screenings. 2



Patients who had a mammogram prior to being diagnosed with breast cancer incurred 21.2% (\$5,000) lower costs than those who did not undergo a mammogram prior to diagnosis. 2



PCPs diagnose and manage up to 80% of common mental health conditions. 3

Our analysis shows that PCP engagement is important for all plan members but even more crucial for your chronic population.

The cost of unmanaged hypertension cases is **200**% more than those who manage the condition. 4

Providing free maintenance medications has a positive impact on drug adherence, therefore reducing costs long-term.


